Mobile Health Outreach Bus (MHOB)

Oxford County Community Health Center (OCCHC): Provide resources, referrals, support with paperwork, advocacy, collaboration with other agencies as well as many tangible items; snacks, sleeping bags/mats, hat & mitts, hygiene supplies, etc.

Primary care available every Monday in Woodstock. Ingersoll and Tillsonburg rotates primary care every other week. With this comes access to wound care, acute/episodic medical conditions, ability to provide prescriptions and order test. Target population is homeless, precariously housed, those who lack access to primary care and feel unsafe accessing traditional care.

Canadian Mental Health Association: Attending to mental health needs in the moment, completing referrals to ongoing support, encouraging connecting with their current supports, or booking in appointments with CMHA.

Oxford County Human Services: Direct connect for clients to Human Services supports: OW, Housing, source for community referrals. Emergency housing referrals and administers CHPI for last month's rent deposits to secure housing. Part of Oxford County's collaborative efforts with community agencies/supports. Oxford County Human Services also provides funding for other formal Outreach Programs in community.

Regional HIV Aids Connection - Attends every other Monday.
